

What do you need:

- loo roll middle,
- parcel paper/newspaper,
- string,
- pens,
- scissors,
- soil,
- seeds
- water.



- 1 Cut a square of parcel paper/newspaper
- 2 Draw round loo roll
- 3 Cut paper into a cross shape with circle in the middle
- 4 Bring each end of the parcel paper/newspaper to the roll, overlapping each other.
- 5 Secure the paper with string, going round a couple of times



- 6 Draw a nice picture on the front
- 7 Add soil to the inside of the roll
- 8 Bury a seed in the soil
- 9 Sprinkle water on top.
